

Oklacon Art Show and Auction Agreement

Policies and Procedures

1. Oklacon will host an art show where artists may showcase their original work, or prints thereof, to registered attendees and optionally take bids for auction of the entry.
2. The art show will be divided into two areas: a general audience art show and a mature art show. The Oklacon Art Director will have sole discretion in deciding what items are allowable in the general audience art show and what items are restricted to the mature art show.
3. Only registered, paid attendees will be granted access to the art shows at Oklacon. Only attendees over the age of 18 at the start of the convention will be granted access to the mature art show or be allowed to place bids on mature art items. Those without convention badges will not be permitted entry to the art show.
4. Art show panels for both the general and mature art shows are 4' by 4' and cost \$10 each. Charity auction items not authored by the entrant will be displayed free of charge by the convention on convention-owned charity panels. Each pre-registered and prepaid attendee may purchase up to four art show panels before October 1 by sending both this signed agreement and either a money order or a check made payable in the correct amount to "Oklacon" and mailed to the address below. Do not mail cash.
5. Only the Guest of Honor Artist shall receive free (up to four) art show panels. All other entrants, including Oklacon volunteers, must pay to reserve space.
6. No one is allowed to sell artwork outside of the Art Show and Auction, Artists Alley, and Dealer's Den.
7. Artists who want to allow agents to enter work into the art show and auction on their behalf must provide their agent with a signed letter of permission.
8. Unclaimed or otherwise available art show panels may be purchased at the door by cash only. The Oklacon Art Director will consider art show panels that are not claimed by Saturday, October 14, unclaimed and forfeited even if they are paid for in advance. No refunds will be issued for unclaimed art show panels. Artists on the waiting list for space will be given a chance to purchase unclaimed art panels for the same price on a first-come, first-serve basis. The Oklacon Art Director shall maintain all waiting lists and be the sole determiner of space availability.
9. The Oklacon Art Director shall label each art show item, and no individual other than the item entrant will be allowed to remove any item from the art show at the end of the show. No items may be removed early from the show or have their item sheets altered to reflect a change in status once entered.
10. Oklacon will make reasonable efforts to ensure all art show items are securely displayed and stored. However, neither Oklacon nor Fuzzy Productions, LLC assumes liability for damaged, lost, or stolen items from the art show. If the artist or agent responsible for the items is not present to monitor and provide security for items, they accept responsibility for any damage or loss that may occur.
11. All items must be displayed with their issued art show item sheets. Artists must either clearly mark items 'NFS' for "Not for Sale" or properly fill out the form to indicate they will be in the voice auction. The Oklacon Art Director shall remove all items which are missing their art show item sheets or have incomplete item sheets from the show until the issues are resolved.
12. Items left after the close of the convention shall become the property of Fuzzy Productions, LLC. Items shall be returned to the original artist within 90 days of the convention at the artist's shipping and insurance expense. Abandoned items shall be auctioned off by Fuzzy Production, LLC in the next following Oklacon Charity Auction.
13. Oklacon will deduct a 10% commission fee from all non-charity sales for the successful sell of an item to a bidder. The commission fee shall be donated in full to the convention charity on behalf of Fuzzy Productions, LLC. All money collected for charity sales will be donated in full to the convention charity on behalf of the donor.

Content

1. Oklacon reserves the right to refuse service or display privileges to anyone. The Oklacon Art Director has final say in all matters concerning what items are allowed and how items are allowed to be displayed.
2. Oklacon is a themed convention, and the Oklacon Art Show and Auction is a themed event. All entries should be substantially depicting anthropomorphic an "anthropomorphic" (animals with human characteristics), "theriomorphic" (humans with animal characteristics), wildlife, or science fiction/fantasy creature nature.
3. Characters which are trademarked, subject to copyright, or which are the well-known property of a person other than the artist may not be displayed without permission of the holder of the trademark/owner of the copyright/creator of the character. Written proof of permission from the trademark/copyright/character owner must be provided.
4. Physical weapons, no matter how artistic, may not be displayed.
